

## Supply List for Fractured Quilt Class

**Fabric** - Yardage will depend on the size of the repeat. You will need at least four repeats of fabric. If you want to use the same fabric in the border you will need extra fabric. The print of the fabric that you choose for the fractured part of the quilt is important. It should have large images with lots of details. There can be some open areas in the background. Large flowers, fish, and butterflies would work nicely in this quilt. I recommend that you wait until you have completed the fractured part of the quilt to choose your inner border. The same is true if you decide to choose a different fabric for the outer border.

6 1/2" x 24" ruler

Cutting Mat at least 18" x 24"

Rotary Cutter with a sharp blade

Scissors

Pins

Thread

Paper and pencil or pen to label fabric strips

Sewing Machine
