

TOOL CADDY

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Friday afternoon

Come make a tool tote that will stand up next to your machine so all your needed supplies will be at your fingertips. It will close and protect the supplies you put in it. Also the fleece will make a pincushion for convenience at retreats and classes.

This project is easy to make. You should leave with a finished project!

Supply list: Can use all one color or each cover and pocket in different colors/prints.

Outside cover:	15 1/2" X 22"
Inside cover:	15 1/2" X 22"
Pocket 1	15 1/2" X 22"
Pocket 2	15 3/4" X 12"
Pocket 3	15 3/4" X 9"
Pocket 4	15 3/4" X 7"
Polar Fleece	10" X 16"

1/16" thick mat board—I purchased my board at Dollar Tree.

½ to 1" wide elastic band. If you use an elastic headband, you will need to cut it and add fabric to it to stretch around your tool tote. I purchased this from Dollar Tree and cut it.

Other Equipment:

Sewing machine, needle, thread (Don't forget footpedal and plug in)

Rotary cutter, ruler and mat

Pinking shears or wavy rotary cutter blade (I have both and will bring them for you to use)

Pencil or chalk marker

Utility knife to cut and score mat board

Clear packing tape for mat board
