

## Featherweight Collage Fabric Supply List

This is the list from the back of the pattern. You may find that the amount of fabrics listed is more than you will need. However, it is better to have more than not enough.

**Background:** 6" to 10" squares of 14 different fabrics for the background. These fabrics should be light; creams, whites, script, and sewing prints work well.

**Featherweight:** 6" squares of 8 different black fabrics (other colors may be used)  
11" square of accent fabric. I use gray on the black machine and pink on my red machine.  
10" square of fabric for the base of the machine (black print)  
Quilt on left side of machine under presser foot. 10" square of Primary underlay of the quilt. I use 2 coordinating fabrics for my Quilt.

**Cuttables:** I refer to these as doo-dads. These are used on the sewing machine, quilt and background. 12X11 of 2 different large scale florals, 6X11 of 10 medium scale florals, 6" squares of 4-5 small scale florals.  
Also include fun motifs such as scissors, pincushions, dress forms  
I will have extra doo-dad fabric to share.

**Thread spool:** 6" square of 2 different fabrics for the thread.

**Table:** 3X11 strips of 6 different yellow fabrics for the table. I have used brown wood grain fabric as well.

**Backing:** One yard of fabric

**Binding:** 6" X WOF for binding

Six yards of 12" wide Steam a Seam 2. I will have some to purchase if you need it.

Sharp scissors - I use Karen K. Buckley medium scissors but any sharp pair of scissors will work

Fine point black Sharpie

Everyone needs to bring an applique pressing sheet.

You will **not** need your sewing machine to complete the quilt top.

The pattern will be drawn out for you on Pattern Ease Foundation at no extra charge. There will be extra Pattern Ease available for purchase.
