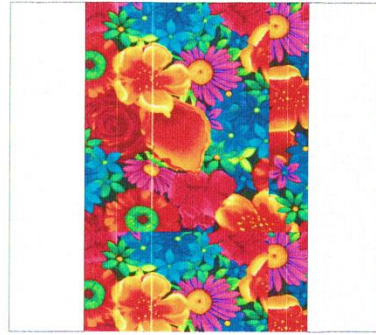
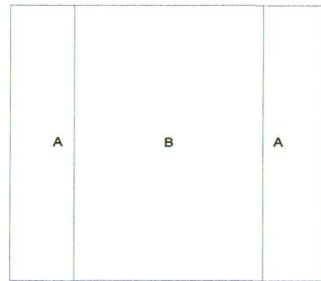
Focus Fabric Substitute Bordered Rail Fence

Focus Fabric Substitute Bordered Rail Fence Block

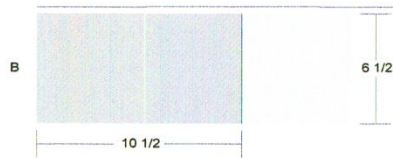
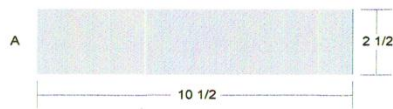

Focus Fabric Substitute Bordered Fence Quilt Instructions

WOF – Width of Fabric Needed

5 – half yard Bold Focus Fabrics (Coordinating Themes)

3 – half yard solid reading or light reading fabrics to go with coordinating fabrics

Makes

Top Size – 50 ½" X 60 ½"

This amount of fabric will make more blocks than is needed for this quilt. Please return with top to community service.

To make the best use of these fabrics

- Cut solid reading or light reading fabrics into 2 ½" strips. Then cut these strips into 10 ½" pieces
- Next Cut Bold Focus Fabrics into strips 6 ½" X WOF. Then cut these strips into 10 ½" center blocks. Giving you 10 ½" X 6 ½" centers.
- To assemble blocks sew 10 ½" strips to 10 ½" side of the 6 ½" X 10 ½" centers. Making 30 blocks.
- To assemble the quilt alternate 10 ½" square blocks turning the blocks back and forth 90 degrees, like shown in picture. Now sew rows together then rows to each other.
