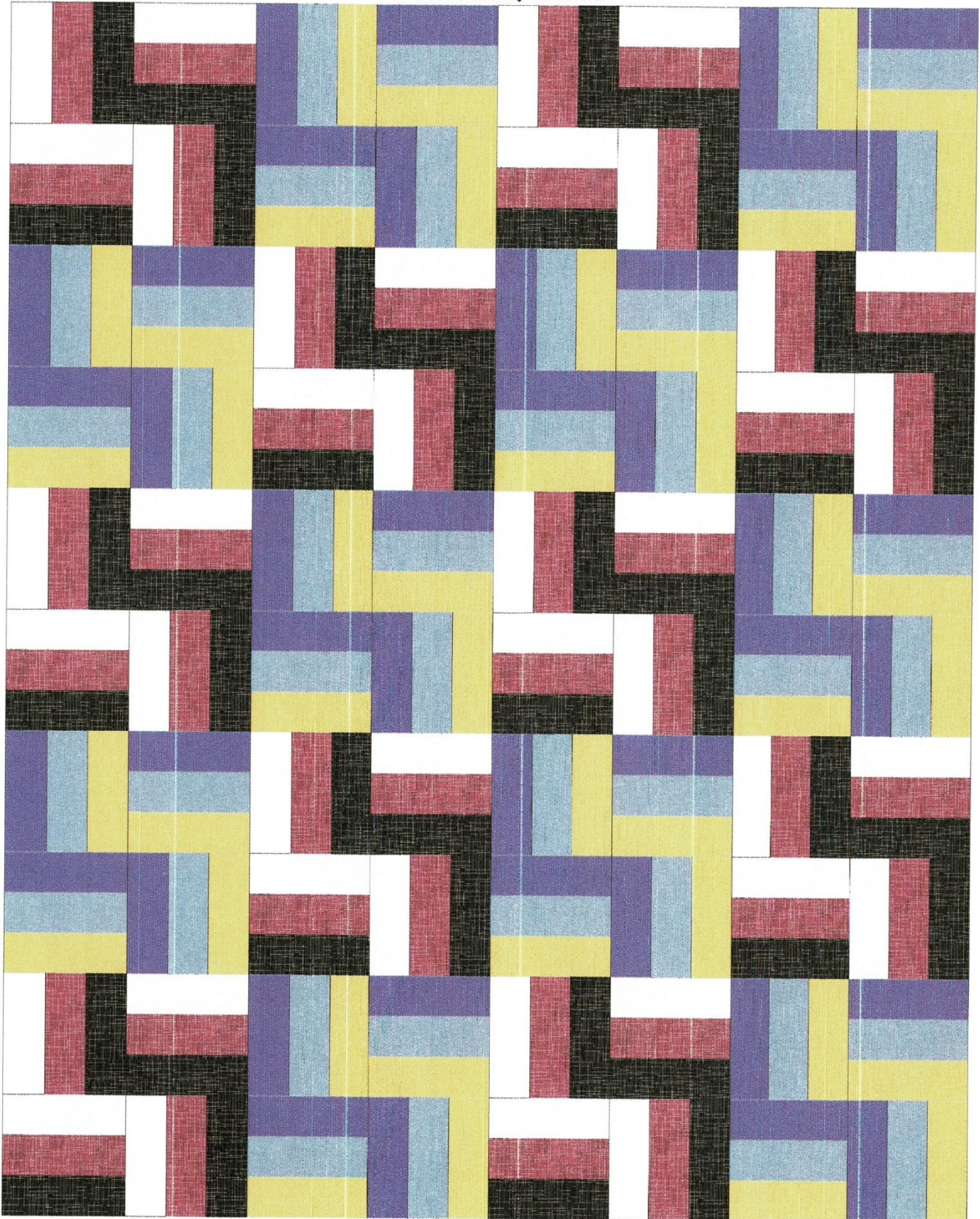

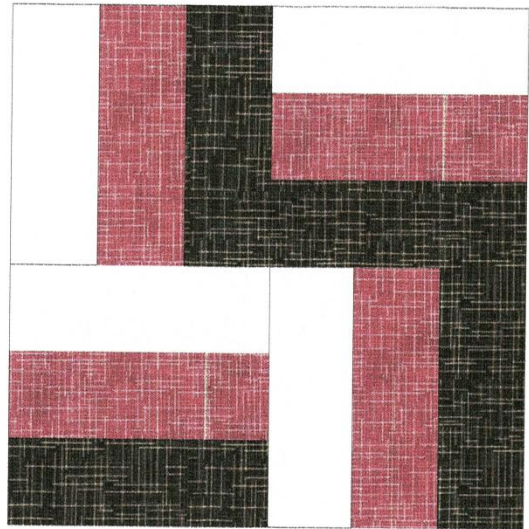
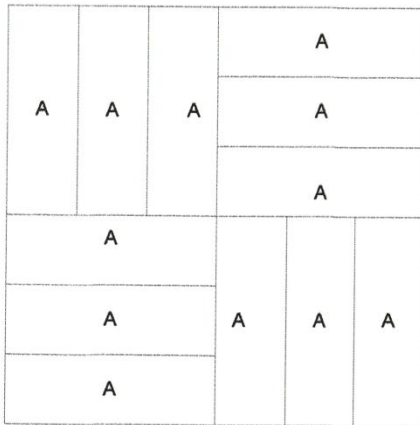
Rail Fence Quilt

Overall Size: 48.00 by 60.00 inches



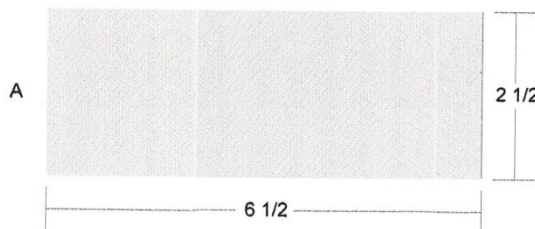
Rail Fence

Rail Fence Quilt

WOF – Width of Fabric

12" Finished Blocks

12 1/2" Unfinished

Quilt Layout 4 blocks wide

5 blocks down

Finished Quilt Size

48" X 60"

This yields more blocks than this quilt needs. Please return extra blocks with quilt top.

Needed

6- half yards of fabrics (2 sets of 3 color coordinating fabrics)

This will make at least 10 blocks in each color wave

Following this method will make the most blocks

- Cut the salvages off all of the half yard fabrics.
- Cut each of the 6-half yard fabrics into 2 1/2" X WOF
- Sew each color strip (same color to same color) end to end.
- Repeat for all colors.
- Sew 3 coordinating colors to each other, lightest to darkest. This makes one long strip 6 1/2" tall.
- Cut the long 6 1/2" strip into 6 1/2" square blocks.
- Sew four of the 6 1/2" squares into a 12 1/2" unfinished square block resembling the above picture.
- Repeat for the second set of 3 coordinating colors.
- Use 10 of each coordinating color set to make a finished quilt top.
